

FY 2026 Appropriations


- \$58 Million Education Trust Fund (ETF)
- \$108 Million Raise Act Fund



Weighted Factors

- Students in Poverty
 - Up to 20% of the BFF
- Special Education Students
 - Up to 25% (Tier 1)
 - 50% (Tier 2)
 - 150% (Tier 3) of the BFF
- English Language Learners (ELL)
 - Up to 15% of the BFF
 - Additional 5% for districts with large, concentrated populations
- Gifted Students
 - Up to 5% of the BFF for 5% of Average Daily Membership (ADM) in each district
- Charter School Students
 - Up to 10% of the BFF

Accountability



- Review Committee
 - Reviews funding factors and weighted allocations
- Accountability and Implementation Board
 - Monitors progress of schools
 - Reviews plans and reports
 - Holds hearings for deficient schools
